DEDAM is the first language research, application and teaching center by **Dokuz Eylül University**. Its objective is to teach not only Turkish but also other foreign languages in a modern and authentic teaching and learning environment with an innovative insight.

DEDAM aims to be acknowledged both nationally and internationally as a center at which Turkish and other modern languages are researched and taught.

The Turkish courses are made up of six levels: A1, A2 (elementary); B1, B2 (intermediate) and C1, C2 (advanced). The learners enrolled at the course are first given a level placement test.

At DEDAM, the language program involves courses which targets to improve four language skills, i.e. listening, reading, writing and speaking, which contributes to intercultural communication.





DEDAM also offers extra curricular activities such as daily excursions, film shows and critical reading activities for the students to get to know Turkish culture.

When the students have completed the course, they will get a certificate, certifying the successful completion of the level of the course they have attended.
